Please read and follow these instructions when completing the application. If you have questions about how to complete the application, please contact your school counselor or Mary Kane, COCAP Scholarship Chairman.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

You are eligible to apply if you meet the first three of the following criteria:

1. You must be a **female** residing in one of the following cities: Orange, Santa Ana, Tustin, North Tustin area, Garden Grove or Villa Park.
2. You must be planning to enroll by September 2011 at a **four-year** college that has NPC sororities on campus.
3. You must submit a completed application **not later than 5:00 pm March 21, 2011** to the address shown below.
4. If you are a finalist, you must be available for a personal interview in April. (We will work with your schedule to find a convenient time and date).
5. If you are a finalist, you must present us with proof of enrollment at a four-year college that has national sororities by September 30, 2011. If you are a winner, you *or* a representative (your mother, grandmother, sister, counselor, etc.) must be present in October 2011 to receive your \$1,000 check. You or your representative will be our guest at our Athena Benefit Luncheon.
